

# Using Scriptures in Prayer

You can use the prayers below when praying with patients or use your own scriptures and follow the prayer format.

## **THE LORD'S PRAYER (Matthew 6:9-13)**

**Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be Your name.**

PRAYER: Father God, we thank you that you are our Father. That we are your children. We thank you that we have the honor and privilege of coming to you in prayer. We recognize your holiness. We recognize your authority. Your name is great and greatly to be praised.

**Thy Kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth as it is in heaven.**

PRAYER: Father we ask that Your kingdom come. We ask that Your will be done. We ask for unity and reconciliation. We ask for supernatural peace and healing in the situation.

**Give us this day our daily bread.**

PRAYER: Father, we thank you that your Word tells us that you give us our daily bread. We ask you for your abundant supply to become real in our lives both in the natural and the spiritual. May we hear what you want to say to us in and through Your Word, Lord. In Jesus' name!

**Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive them that trespass against us.**

PRAYER: Forgiveness is so important. Not only for others but also for ourselves. We must forgive and keep on forgiving to allow the flow of His grace to operate in and through us.

**Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.**

PRAYER: Another way to say this is "You don't lead us into temptation, but You deliver us from evil." It's important to recognize how He leads us so we can discern His leading versus our own flesh.

**For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory, forever and ever. Amen.**

PRAYER: Father, we thank you that yours is the kingdom, the power and the glory. We thank you that you are in all things. That you are the beginning and the end. That we can leave our prayers in your hands knowing that you are sovereign and your plans for us are for good and not for evil, to give us a future and a hope. In Jesus' name!

## **ISAIAH 53:4 (NASB)**

However, it was our sicknesses that He Himself bore, and our pains that He carried; Yet we ourselves assumed that He had been afflicted, struck down by God and humiliated.

PRAYER: Father God, we thank you that according to Isaiah 53:4, your word says that you bore our griefs and carried our sorrows and pains. That by your stripes we are healed and made whole. Father, in Jesus' name, we speak this word over \_\_\_\_\_. We thank you that you bore their griefs and carried their sorrows and pains. We thank you that by your stripes, they are healed and made whole. We ask that you would help them find the best path of healing for them in Jesus' name. Amen.

# Using Scriptures in Prayer

## **PSALM 107:20 (NKJV)**

He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

PRAYER: Father, we thank you that according to Psalm 107:20, you sent your word and healed us and delivered us from our destructions. Lord, we ask for our brother. We ask that you heal him and deliver him from all his destructions, in Jesus' name! We thank you that it is done. Amen.

## **EPHESIANS 4:31-32 (NASB)**

All bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and slander be removed from you, along with all malice. Be kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

PRAYER: Father God, we thank you that according to Ephesians 4:31, your word says to let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, slander and malice be put away from us. Lord, your word says to be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another as God is in Christ has forgiven us. I ask that you would help us to put these negative things away from us. I ask that you would help us to be kind to each other. Lord, we forgive as you have forgiven us. We choose to walk in forgiveness and we thank you for this in Jesus' name.

## **EPHESIANS 3:14-19 (NKJV)**

For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height—to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

PRAYERS (insert names):
